

Proposed cleanup at former BP gas station in Yamhill

Comments due: 5 p.m., Friday Dec. 31, 2021

Project location: Former Carol Glover BP service station, 185 S. Maple Street, Yamhill

Proposal: The Department of Environmental Quality proposes to remove hazardous building materials, the former service station building, underground fuel storage tanks, and hydraulic hoists beneath the building. The proposal is presented in an Assessment of Brownfield Cleanup Alternatives report. Funding for the assessment and cleanup is provided by EPA's and Business Oregon's brownfields programs.
