

## RESOLUTION No. 2019-3576

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH K&E PAVING, INC. DBA H&H PAVING FOR THE 2019 PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,139,270.50

## RECITALS:

- 1. The City's consultant, Kittelson Associates, Inc., completed the construction plans and the bid documents for the 2019 Pavement Rehabilitation Project.
- 2. The 2019 Pavement Rehabilitation Project, the second of two pavement maintenance and rehabilitation projects, is an approved capital improvement project in the 2019-2020 fiscal year budget.
- 3. The City of Newberg advertised the project on the city's website and in the Daily Journal of Commerce on May 14, 2019, soliciting bids in accordance with ORS Chapter 279C Public Contracting and Public Procurement requirements.
- 4. Four (4) qualified and responsive bid were received on June 11, 2019. The lowest responsible and responsive bid was submitted by K&E Paving, Inc. dba H&H Paving for a total of \$1,139,268.50.
- 5. The City exercises its bid options to receive milled asphaltic material from K&E Paving, Inc. dba H&H Paving. This resulted in a proposed total contract of \$1,139,270.50 for the project.

## THE CITY OF NEWBERG RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. The City Council, acting as contract review board for the city, does hereby authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with K&E Paving, Inc. dba H&H Paving to complete the 2019 Pavement Rehabilitation Project in the amount of \$1,139,270.50.
- 2. The City Attorney will review and approve all contracts and agreements as to form and content.
- 3. The City Manager is authorized to negotiate and approve any needed construction change orders not to exceed 10 percent of the original contract amount.

EFFECTIVE DATE of this resolution is the day after the adoption date, which is: July 2, 2019. ADOPTED by the City Council of the City of Newberg, Oregon, this 1st day of July, 2019.
