

RESOLUTION No. 2022-3823



A Resolution authorizing the City Manager to enter into a construction contract with Trench Line Excavation, Inc. for the S River Street Waterline Improvement Project in the amount of \$1,367,849.60.

Recitals:

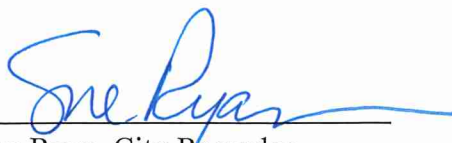
1. The 2017 Water Master Plan, updated in 2021 provides guidance for operations, maintenance and expansion of the City's water distribution system. The need has been identified for the replacement of an older high maintenance 6-inch cast iron pipeline in S River Street from E Fourth Street to E Twelfth Street. The replacement of this waterline will address failing pipe, provide additional fire flow and provide seismic resiliency.
2. In March 2021, the City retained Century West Engineering to design the 12-inch ductile iron watermain for the S River Street Waterline Improvement Project. The Engineer's estimate for the project was in the range of \$1.3 million to \$1.6 million.
3. On April 20, 2022, the City advertised the project in the Daily Journal of Commerce, and on the City's bid management website, soliciting bids in accordance with ORS Chapter 279D Public Contracting and Public Procurement requirements.
4. On May 10, 2022, the City received and opened five qualified bids. Trench Line Excavation's bid is determined to be the lowest and responsive to the City's bid request.
5. Construction is planned to begin this summer for completion in May 2023.

The City of Newberg Resolves as Follows:

1. The City Council, acting as contract review board for the City, does hereby authorize the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Trench Line Excavation, Inc. to complete the S River Street Waterline Improvement Project in the amount of \$1,367,849.60.
2. The City Attorney will review and approve all contracts as to form and content.

Effective Date of this resolution is the day after the adoption date, which is: June 7, 2022.
