

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-3861



A resolution awarding the design consultant contract to Murraysmith, Inc and authorizing the City Manager execute all contract documents for the New Groundwater Treatment Plant Project

Recitals:

1. The City of Newberg's existing groundwater treatment plant is aging and has infrastructure that is required to be updated/replaced.
2. In the Fall of 2021, the City re-evaluated the approach to update the plant and decided to construct a new Groundwater Treatment Plant instead.
3. Per our agreement with Oregon Health Authority- Drinking Water Section (OHA-DWS), our implementation timeline states that the new Plant will be operational by September 1, 2027.
4. The design consultant that the City hires will need to be extremely well versed in the design of a treatment plant, the City's system and all federal funding procurement requirements. The Groundwater Treatment Plant will be carefully engineered and built to better withstand natural disasters, protect public health, protect against other hazards, speed recovery in emergencies, and provide safe, reliable water for the citizens of Newberg for at least the next 50 years.
5. A Request for Proposals was advertised in the Daily Journal of Commerce on August 1, 2022. On August 24, 2022, one proposal was received from Murraysmith, Inc. Murraysmith is very familiar with designing a Groundwater Treatment Plant, the City's water system and the federal procurement requirements. The proposed fee of \$4,621,082.00 for this scope of work is within the overall project budget.
6. Staff recommends that Murraysmith, Inc. be granted the design consultant contract.

The City of Newberg Resolves as Follows:


1. City Council hereby approves the award of the design consultant contract to Murraysmith, Inc. and authorizes the City Manager to execute the contracts.
2. The City Attorney will review and approve all contract documents as to form and content.

Effective Date of this resolution is the day after the adoption date, which is: October 4, 2022.
