Recommendation:

To approve the purchase of a new storage appliance to replace the existing one.

Executive Summary:

The city would like to purchase a new storage appliance to replace the existing one, which has reached end of life, and maintenance and support costs have begun to increase as a result. The new appliance is sized to last 5 years and includes maintenance and support for the duration of the life of the appliance. The IT Capital Outlay account has funds available for this purchase. Per section 8.3.4 of the City Purchasing Manual, any purchase over \$100,000 requires approval from the City Council before purchasing the equipment.

Fiscal Impact: The IT Capital Outlay account has funds available for this purchase, and it is part of the IT Department's capital roll-over plan. The price is \$184,214.99

Council Goals: Goal 1: This storage appliance allows city servers to function faster and with more flexibility, the servers are used either directly or indirectly by all departments. Without keeping this equipment up to date, we have the increased potential for outages affecting large numbers of city staff.

Goal 6: As this kind of equipment ages, the cost for maintenance agreements begins to increase significantly, as the likelihood of component failure increases with age. Replacing the appliance now will provide the city considerable cost savings in maintenance agreements, and will significantly reduce the potential for large-scale computer outages effecting staff members.
