Since you are unable to access your work files at DEQ right now Molalla can certainly supply you these documents. The City's Biosolids Management Plan, along with most documents are available on the City website, here is the direct link to the plan, and to our broader documents page. Please be advised that at this time we do not consider any of the sites suitable or ready for land application, this plan would need to be updated. But as it stands now the future WWTF being constructed will not include land application as part of its processes, so it's unclear how this plan might change in the future.
