Dear Brandon,

Thank you for your response to DEQ comments and submittal of the July 2023 revised Site Investigation report for the UPRR cleanup site in Sheridan. I have reviewed the report and comment responses and have the following additional comments.

1. Agreed that the arsenic levels in SB-09, 1-2 feet do not appear to be representative of overall site conditions. However, the concentration at that location is significantly above DEQ's occupational and construction worker Risk Based Concentrations and may warrant further investigation before a No Further Action decision can be made without significant restrictions on property use.
2. Although MW-7 is located on the adjacent property, the current and past data suggests the Former Bulk Fuel Terminal as the source of petroleum contamination to this well. Groundwater flow from the bulk tanks is towards the east and MW-7. Current and past groundwater data from MW-4, GW-05, GW03, P1 and P2 all point to the tanks as the source. More evidence would be needed to eliminate the bulk fuel tanks as the source to groundwater in MW-7.

Please let me know if you have any questions or would like to set up a meeting to discuss the next steps for the project.

Please either respond by requesting a meeting or with a proposal on how you plan to address the above comments by July 31, 2023. The site should be close to closure once the couple of issues above are resolved.
