WHEREAS, the grant award has been accepted; and

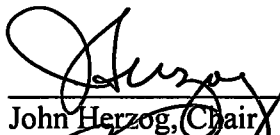
WHEREAS, the grant requires the Board of Curry County Commissioners to adopt an excessive force policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF CURRY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS HEREBY RESOLVES that it is the policy of Curry County that:

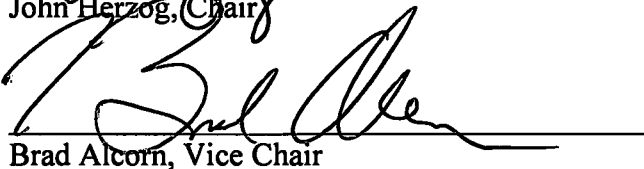
- 1) Curry County law enforcement personnel shall not use excessive force against any individuals engaged in nonviolent civil rights demonstrations, and
- 2) Applicable state and local laws that prohibit physically barring entrance to or exit from a facility or location which is the subject of such nonviolent civil rights demonstrations within its jurisdiction shall be enforced.

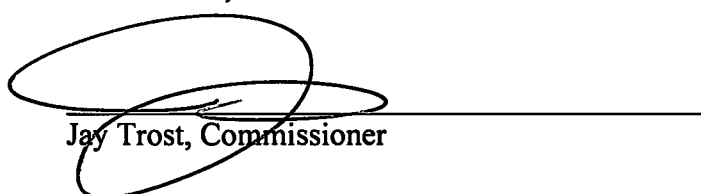

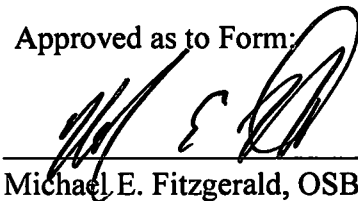
