WHEREAS, on November 30, 2022, a 2017 Ford Explorer valued at approximately \$25,000.00 operated by Curry County Sheriff's Office ("CCSO") Patrol was involved in an accident and deemed as totaled; and

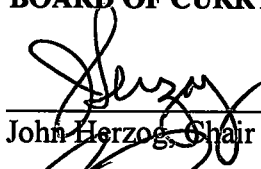
WHEREAS, because the accident only involved a single vehicle, there is no possibility of payment from third party insurance, meaning the County must use its Self Insurance Fund; and

WHEREAS, there is a sufficient balance in the Self Insurance fund to account for the loss of the vehicle.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the transfer of \$25,000.00 from the General Equipment Self Insurance Account to the Vehicle Replacement Account is approved; with such funding being reserved for the replacement of the CCSO Patrol vehicle.

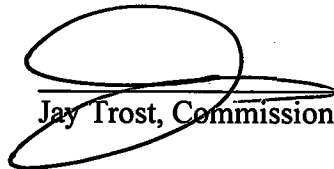

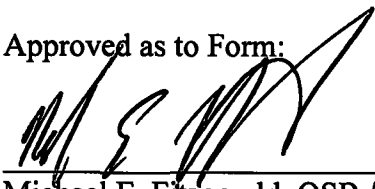
