Chair Herzog entered Executive Session at 9:16 a.m. and exited at 10:34 a.m.

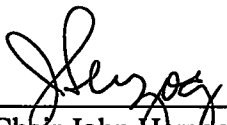

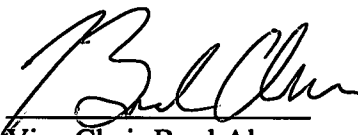
