**ORDER NO. 23205**

**WHEREAS**, on or about December 10, 2022, a 2005 CAT 924 Loader (“Loader”) operated by the Road Department sustained engine damage during storm damage mitigation in North County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Roadmaster received a quote from Petersen CAT for an engine replacement totaling a sum of \$31,298.11, including a core charge for the new engine.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**


1. Concurrent with removal of the Loader engine, Road Department will direct Petersen CAT to run electronic diagnosis on the engine to determine the reason for damage.
2. All staff and equipment documentation associated with the engine damage and replacement shall be retained for FEMA reimbursement purposes.
3. The Roadmaster is authorized to proceed with an engine replacement for the Loader, to be completed by Petersen CAT in the sum of \$31,298.11; providing that (if feasible) the damaged engine core shall be returned for a core charge credit.


