WHEREAS, the Curry County Juvenile Department works with youth to promote pro social behaviors; and

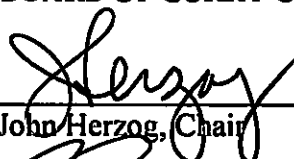
WHEREAS, the Roundhouse Foundation offers funding for rural communities to fundamentally thrive in Arts and Culture; and

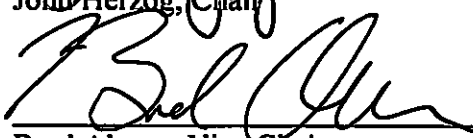

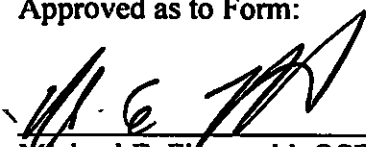

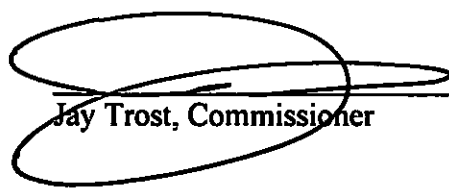
