DEQ issued a Call-In Letter to Biomass One, L.P. (Biomass One), DEQ Air Quality Source Number 15-0159, on April 26, 2024 - this Call-In Letter serves as the notice date that the source was "called-in" to the Cleaner Air Oregon (CAO) program to complete a Risk Assessment under Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 340-245-0050(1). On June 13, 2024, Biomass One notified DEQ that they will be performing source testing to supplement their CAO Emissions Inventory (Inventory). In accordance with OAR 340-245-0030(1)(a)(B), existing sources choosing to perform and submit DEQ-approved source testing to supplement their Inventory are provided an additional 60 days, or 150 days after issuance date of the Call-In Letter, to submit their Inventory. Additionally, the rules require these sources to submit their Modeling Protocol and Risk Assessment Work Plan (if applicable) by no later than 150 days from the issuance date of the Call-In Letter.

Based on the decision to source test prior to submitting the Inventory, the following revisions and next steps are required:

- Submit a Source Test Plan to DEQ for review and approval at least 30 days prior to proposed testing date; particularly complex source testing programs may require 45 days or more for protocol approval. DEQ's Source Sampling Manual and other information related to source testing can be found on DEQ's web site at: https://www.oregon.gov/deg/ag/agPermits/Pages/Source-Monitoring.aspx.
- Submit a Source Test Report to DEQ within 60 days of completion of the proposed source testing.
- 3. In accordance with OAR 340-245-0030(1)(a)(B) submit the Inventory Form (AQ520) and all required supplementary materials [OAR 340-245-0040(4)], Modeling Protocol, and Risk Assessment Work Plan (if applicable) by no later than **150 days** after the issuance date of the Call-in Letter, or **September 23, 2024**.

If for any reason Biomass One elects to forgo this source testing, then Biomass One must submit the Inventory by no later than **90 days** from the issuance date of the Call-In Letter, or **July 25, 2024**. [OAR <u>340-245-0030(1)(a)(A)]</u>. In this case, the Modeling Protocol and Risk Assessment Work Plan deadlines are based on the approval date of the Inventory. [OAR <u>340-245-0030(b)&(c)</u>]
