Bruce, et. al.

I just received analytical results in the mail for the site wastes. Two samples were collected and analyzed for total and TCLP leachable metals, VOCs, PCBs, and pesticides. Pesticides had to be re-analyzed because of interference from undefined organics.

No VOCs, PCBs, or pesticides were detected, but concentrations of total arsenic (31-34 ppm), total lead (161-1,100 ppm), and total silver (1.9-2.0 ppm) were well-above presumed soil background levels, which is not surprising considering that these are wastes.

Only lead was analyzed by TCLP analysis; detected concentrations were well-below levels of RCRA concern, though (0.35 and 0.53 ppm).
