That the OWNER and CONTRACTOR, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, hereby agree as follows:

- 2. That the CONTRACTOR agrees to furnish all materials, tools, equipment and labor necessary, and to perform all work required, for construction of the abovementioned 12-inch replacement pressure pipe main.

- 3. That the applicable parts of the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, in particular, but not limited to, the General Conditions, Special Provisions, Special Specifications, governmental requirements as concerns labor standards and nondiscrimination practices and notices, shall be incorporated by reference as a part of this CONTRACT and shall be complied with as completely as if they were fully set forth herein.
- 4. That the CONTRACTOR agrees that the time limit for completion of this work shall be the /s/ day of MARCH,

 19 7 In the event that the CONTRACTOR shall fail to complete the work within the time limit or the extended time limit agreed upon, as more particularly set forth in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, liquidated damages shall be paid by the CONTRACTOR to the OWNER at the rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per day. Sundays and legal holidays shall be excluded in determining days of default.
- 5. That the CONTRACTOR shall provide a Performance Bond, in conformance with the general description given in the General Conditions of the CONTRACT DOCUMENT, in the amount of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000).
- 6. That the CONTRACTOR agrees to indemnify and save harmless the OWNER from any and all defects appearing or developing in the materials furnished and the workmanship performed under this CONTRACT for a period of one (1) year after the date of acceptance of the work by the OWNER.
- 7. That the provisions required by ORS 279.350 relating to prevailing wage rates are made a part of this CONTRACT as completely as if the same were fully set forth herein.
- 8. As payment for the above-described work, the OWNER agrees to pay the CONTRACTOR on the basis of paragraph F-2c. Force Account Work, of the General Conditions of the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS. The OWNER further agrees to pay the CONTRACTOR an additional sum equal

to the premium required for the Performance Bond described in paragraph 5 above.
