## INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITY OF NEWBERG AND TUALATIN VALLEY FIRE AND RESCUE

This agreement is made and entered into by and among the City of Newberg, hereinafter "City" and Tualatin Valley Fire and Rescue, a Rural Fire Protection District, hereinafter "District" pursuant to the provisions of ORS 190.003 - 190.250.

WHEREAS, City desires consultant services for the purpose of life safety plans review and other related fire prevention services, and;

WHEREAS, District is engaged in the business of providing such services;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein, it is agreed between the parties:

- 1. <u>INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR SERVICES.</u> City hereby contracts with District, and District accepts the contract, to provide services upon the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- 2. <u>TERM.</u> The effective date of this agreement shall be December 18, 1995 and will continue until the City determines that District services are no longer needed. Either party may terminate this agreement by providing thirty days notice to the other party.
- 3. <u>DUTIES.</u> For their part, the District shall provide consultant services as follows:
  - A. Serve as an assistant to the Fire Chief and perform duties consistent with that of a Fire Marshal.
  - B. Conduct life safety plans review.

For their part, the City agrees to coordinate all scheduling of services with the District's Fire Marshal or his designee. The City understands that a circumstance may arise whereby the District cannot provide immediate service under this agreement.

4. <u>COMPENSATION.</u> City shall pay District for work performed. Payment shall be remitted from progress billings submitted by District. Fees are as follows:

Hourly rate Incidental expenses Mileage

\$40.00 as incurred \$.35 per mile

- 7. <u>APPLICABLE LAW.</u> This agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with laws of the State of Oregon.
- 8. <u>INDEMNIFICATION</u>. Each party to this agreement shall be responsible for damage to persons or property resulting from negligence on the part of itself, its employees, its agents, or its officers. Neither party assumes any responsibility to the other party for the consequences of any act or omission of any person or corporation not a party to this agreement.
- 9. <u>EXCLUSIVE TERMS/ASSIGNMENT.</u> The provisions of this agreement are for the benefit of the parties solely. Neither party shall assign, amend or otherwise transfer their respective rights and obligations under this agreement without written consent of the other party.
- 10. <u>ENTIRE AGREEMENT.</u> This instrument contains the entire Agreement of the parties. No amendment or variation of the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall be valid unless it is in writing and signed by all parties.
