This amendment is entered into this ___day of November, 2001, by and between the City of Newberg, hereinafter referred to as "City" and the Office and Professional Employees International Union Local #11, hereinafter referred to as "Union".

RECITALS:

- On July 31, 2000, the City and the Union entered into an agreement for a term from July 1, 2000 through June 30, 2003.
- 2. ARTICLE 1. RECOGNITION, Section 1.1 Bargaining Agent and Bargaining Unit provides for recognition of the Union as the exclusive bargaining agent in all matters of wages, hours and conditions of employment for all police officers, corporals, communication officers, code enforcement officers, support services secretary, animal control officer, records & evidence technician, and regular part-time employees, excluding temporary employees (employees hired to work a period not to exceed 90 days), lieutenants, sergeants, communications manager, Chief's secretary, Community Resource Technician/Public Information Officer, and any other confidential and supervisory employees, hereinafter called "employees".
- 3. **SCHEDULE "B" (ARTICLE 11.1 SALARY SCHEDULE)** provides salary schedules for all members represented by the Union, effective July 1, 2000, July 1, 2001, and July 1, 2002.
- 4. The City and the Union have agreed to include "Community Service Officer" to those members for whom the City recognizes the Union as the exclusive bargaining agent in all matters of wages, hours and conditions of employment; and to establish salary schedules for the Community Service Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed between the parties as follows:

1. The Agreement dated July 31, 2000 shall be amended by mutual agreement of the parties.

- 2. ARTICLE 1. RECOGNITION, Section 1.1 Bargaining Agent and Bargaining Unit, shall be amended to read as follows:
 - 1.1 <u>BARGAINING AGENT AND BARGAINING UNIT</u>. The City recognizes the Union as the exclusive bargaining agent in all matters of wages, hours and conditions of employment for all police officers, corporals, communication officers, code enforcement officers, support services secretary, animal control officer, community service officer, records & evidence technician, and regular part-time employees, excluding temporary employees (employees hired to work a period not to exceed 90 days), lieutenants, sergeants, communications manager, Chief's secretary, Community Resource Technician/Public Information Officer, and any other confidential and supervisory employees, hereinafter called "employees".
- 3. **SCHEDULE "B" (ARTICLE 11.1 SALARY SCHEDULE),** shall be amended to read as follows:

AMENDMENT to LABOR AGREEMENT between THE CITY OF NEWBERG POLICE DEPARTMENT and the OFFICE AND PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES

This amendment is entered into this ____day of November, 2001, by and between the City of Newberg, hereinafter referred to as "City" and the Office and Professional Employees

International Union Local #11, hereinafter referred to as "Union".

RECITALS:

INTERNATIONAL UNION LOCAL #11

- 1. On July 31, 2000, the City and the Union entered into an agreement for a term from July 1, 2000 through June 30, 2003.
- 2. ARTICLE 1.
