RESOLUTION 51-24

WHEREAS the male members of the Police Department of the City of Newberg, Oregon, exclusive of Reserve and Junior Police, have been heretofore provided with a monthly allowance for the care and upkeep of their uniforms and equipment in the sum of \$5.00 for each regular male officer; and

WHEREAS the increases in the cost of living during the past several years have rendered said allowance inadequate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Newberg, Oregon, that from and after October 1, 1951, the regular male officers of the Police Department of said City, exclusive of Reserve officers and Junior Police, shall each be paid the sum of \$10.00 per month for the care and upkeep of their police uniforms and equipment.
