RESOLUTION

49-15

WHEREAS Vinnie B. Frost, a single woman; Clara A. Hawley, a single woman; Victor H. Siefker and Marjorie Siefker, husband and wife; R. M. Curtis and Nellie M. Curtis, husband and wife; Irene Goodwin and James W. Goodwin, wife and husband; and Mrs. George V. Dugan and George V. Dugan, wife and husband, are all of the owners of the real property abutting on a certain alley in the City of Newberg, Yamhill County, Oregon, which said alley is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

All of that certain 12 foot alley running East and West through Block 20, Edwards Addition to the Town, now city, of Newberg, Yamhill County, Oregon.

and

WHEREAS all of the aforesaid property owners have heretofore filed with the Recorder of the City of Newberg, a written Petition and request that the aforesaid alley be vacated; and

WHEREAS the aforesaid alley is a dead-end alley in that the portion of Columbia Street formerly intersected by said alley on the East has been heretofore vacated, closing said alley at the Eastern end, and making it impractical to use said alley for traffic and it would be for the best interests of the people of the City of Newberg that said alley be vacated, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Newberg:

1. That the Council of the City of Newberg, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 259, Oregon Laws, 1931, does hereby propose to vacate the following described alley, an alley in said city, to-wit:

All of that certain 12 foot alley running East and West through Block 20, Edwards Addition to the Town, now city, of Newberg, Yamhill County, Oregon.

Right of way Grant attached.

2. That the 7th day of November, 1949, at the hour of 7:50 o'clock P.M. on said day be, and the same hereby is, set as the time, and the Council Rooms of the City of Newberg, in the City Hall, Newberg, Yamhill County, Oregon, be, and the same hereby is, set as the place for the hearing and consideration of written objections or remonstrances, if any, against said proposed vacation of the above described alley.

5. That the Recorder be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to give notice in the manner required by law of the Council's intention to vacate the above described alley by publishing notice once each week for four consecutive and successive weeks in the Newberg Graphic, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the City of Newberg, Yamhill County, Oregon, and by posting, or causing to be posted, copies of said notice at or near each end of said alley proposed to be vacated, and in at least two conspicuous places within such proposed vacation, said notice to contain a description of the alley proposed to be vacated, the date of this Resolution, and the time and place for the hearing by the Council of written objections and remonstrances, if any.
