RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the City of Newberg owns, maintains and operates a police radio station and allied units under license from the Federal Communications Commission; and

WHEREAS the Town of Dundee owns and proposes to operate a mobile transmitting and receiving police radio unit and further proposes to apply for a license from said Federal Communications Commission; and

WHEREAS it is desirable that the Town of Dundee should operate said mobile unit temporarily in connection with the radio units owned by the City of Newberg until such time as such license shall be granted to the Town of Dundee.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Newberg, Oregon:

1. That the Mayor and Recorder be and they hereby are authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the Town of Dundee, Oregon, providing for the temporary use by the Town of Dundee of the present channel of the City of Newberg police radio pending the granting of a license to the Town of Dundee by the Federal Communications Commission, but in any event, for a period of not to exceed six months from date hereof and providing further that the City of Newberg have full control of all operations under said agreement and further retains the right to cancel same or discontinue operations thereunder temporarily or permanently at any time.
