

## RESOLUTION 49-6

WHEREAS the City of Newberg has heretofore provided for the issuance of \$110,000.00 in bonds of said City for the purpose of defraying the cost of the development and improvement of existing and new sources of water supply for said City and for the location and acquisition of such sources and for other purposes in connection with the water system of said City, said bonds having been issued and sold under the terms of Ordinance number 974 of said City, passed and approved March 11, 1946, after an election duly called and held whereby the electors of said City duly approved said bond issue; and

WHEREAS the City of Newberg has heretofore drilled a certain water well on a certain well site owned by the City of Newberg in Marion County, Oregon, in connection with the work covered by said bond issue and has accepted bids to furnish certain water works materials for the construction of a water pipe line from said well to connect same with the water system of the City of Newberg; and

WHEREAS the aforesaid water works materials have been duly furnished and delivered at Newberg and it is now necessary that they be installed.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Newberg that the City Recorder be and he hereby is authorized and directed to publish a notice to bidders in the Newberg Graphic, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the City of Newberg, Yamhill County, Oregon, and in the Daily Journal of Commerce, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in Multnomah County, Oregon, which said notice shall ask for proposals to install certain water works materials consisting of water pipe and appurtances, the principal items of which are as follows:



in accordance with certain specifications, plans, instructions to bidders, proposal and contract, prepared by John W. Cunningham and Associates, 1112 Spalding Building, Portland, 4, Oregon. Said notice shall further provide for opening said proposals on Monday, April 25<sup>th</sup>, 1949, at 2:00 o'clock P.M. on said day at the Council Chambers in the City Hall in Newberg, Oregon, and shall further provide that the said specifications may be examined by prospective bidders at the office of the City Recorder aforesaid and at the office of John W. Cunningham and Associates, 1112 Spalding Building, Portland 4, Oregon. That said notice shall further provide that the City reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to accept the proposal deemed best in the interest of the City, for good and sufficient reasons. Said notice shall be published in said Newberg Graphic on April 7, 14 and 21, 1949, and in said Daily Journal of Commerce on April 11 and 18, 1949.

Said notice shall further provide for a deposit of \$20.00 by prospective bidders requiring delivery of plans and specifications, deposits to be returned when bona fide bid is submitted and plans and specifications returned in good condition. If no bid is submitted and plans and specifications are returned, refund in the amount of \$5.00 shall be made. Bids must be accompanied by certified check payable to the city in an amount not less than 5% of total bid. A 100% surety performance bond shall be required on this contract. A copy of said plans and specifications, proposal and contract is attached to this Resolution and by this reference made a part thereof.
