## RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Newberg, Oregon, that the said Council proposes to improve Harrison Street in the said City by constructing a concrete sidewalk along the west side thereof from the south line of Sheridan Street to the northwesterly line of the right of way of the Oregon-California Railroad; and

along said portion of said street shall be done in accord with and as provided in the plans and specifications for said improvement filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of Newberg, on the first day of June, 1925; that the cost thereof shall include a reasonable sum as engineer's fees and a reasonable sum as attorney's fees; and that the cost of the said improvement is to be assessed to the property abutting on the said portion of the said street so improved and collected in the manner as provided in the Charter of the City of Newberg, and in the laws of the State of Oregon applicable thereto; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Recorder of the said City of Newberg be, and he hereby is, directed to give notice, as provided in the Charter of the City of Newberg of the said proposed improvement, that the Council will at a regular meeting thereof to be held on the 8th day of September, 1925, at 8:00 P.M. in the said City of Newberg, hear and determine objections and remonstrances, if any, to the said proposed improvement and expenditure.
