DEQ has completed its review and approves the revised Cleaner Air Oregon Level 3 Modeling Protocol, Risk Assessment Work Plan, and Risk Assessment, submitted on July 17, 2024, by Bridgewater Group, Inc. on behalf of EcoLube Recovery LLC (ELR) for the ELR facility in Portland, OR. This approval is in accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) <u>340-245-0030</u> and OAR <u>340-245-0050(1)</u>.

The resulting Excess Cancer Risk, Chronic Noncancer Hazard Index, and Acute Noncancer Hazard Index values determined by the risk assessment are all below the Source Permit Level for existing sources and therefore do not require any Source Risk Limits in the permit to limit the risk from toxic air contaminant emissions from this facility at this time.

The next step is for ELR to submit a completed <u>AQ501 CAO Permit Application Form</u>, along with the following fees for Standard Air Contaminant Discharge Permits [<u>OAR 340-216-8030 Table 3</u>], by **September 2, 2024**: [OAR 340-245-0030(1)(h)]
