The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality invites the public to provide written comments on the conditions of City of Yoncalla's proposed water quality permit modification, known officially as a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit.

Summary

Subject to public review and comment, DEQ intends to modify the water quality permit, which allows the City of Yoncalla wastewater treatment plant to discharge wastewater to Yoncalla Creek.

DEQ initiated a permit modification to change compliance schedule deadlines and requirements based on a Mutual Agreement and Order (MAO) amendment finalized with the City of Yoncalla on May 30, 2024. **Comments regarding this modification are limited to the proposed change.**

About the facility

DEQ has initiated a water quality permit modification for the Yoncalla wastewater treatment plant at 380 Halo Trail Road in Yoncalla. DEQ last renewed this permit on Sept. 30, 2021. The facility discharges to Yoncalla Creek at river mile 2.6.

The facility holds no other permits from DEQ.

What types of pollutants does the permit regulate?

The current permit contains conditions for how the facility deals with the following pollutants: biochemical oxygen demand, total suspended solids, *E. coli* bacteria, pH, total residual chlorine, and total ammonia as nitrogen.

Would the draft permit modification change the amount of pollution the facility is allowed to release?

No, the proposed modification does not change the amount of pollution the facility is allowed to release.

Translation or other formats



How did DEQ determine permit requirements?

DEQ evaluates types and amounts of pollutants and the water quality of the surface water or groundwater where the pollutants are proposed to be discharged and determines permit requirements to ensure the proposed discharges will meet applicable statutes, rules, regulations and effluent guidelines of Oregon and the Clean Water Act.

For this proposed permit action, DEQ evaluated the MAO amendment finalized with the City of Yoncalla on May 30, 2024.

How does DEQ monitor compliance with the permit requirements?

This permit will require the facility to monitor pollutants discharged using approved monitoring practices and standards. DEQ reviews the facility's discharge monitoring reports to check for compliance with permit limits.

What happens next?

Submit comments by sending an email or using mail service addressed to the permit coordinator listed in the "how to provide public comment" box above.

DEQ will hold a public hearing if it receives written requests for a hearing during the public comment period from at least 10 people or from an organization representing at least 10 people.

DEQ will consider and respond to all comments received and may modify the proposed permit based on comments.

PERMITTED ACTIVITIES

Until this permit expires or is modified or revoked, the permittee is authorized to: 1) operate a wastewater collection, treatment, control and disposal system; and 2) discharge treated wastewater to waters of the state only from the authorized discharge point or points in Schedule A in conformance with the requirements, limits, and conditions set forth in this permit.

Unless specifically authorized by this permit, by another NPDES or Water Pollution Control Facility permit, or by Oregon statute or administrative rule, any other direct or indirect discharge of pollutants to waters of the state is prohibited.

By 5/31/2024 By 4/30/2026	The permittee must submit a pre-design report to DEQ.
By 8/30/2024 By 7/31/2026	Within 30 days after receiving DEQ comments on the pre-design report, the permittee must respond to DEQ comments and then submit a final pre-design report to DEQ for approval.
By 6/30/2025 By 5/31/2027	The permittee must submit final engineering plans for DEQ review and approval.
By 11/30/2025 By 10/31/2027	The permittee must secure funding for the selected alternative and provide documentation to DEQ.
By 3/31/2026 By 2/29/2028	The permittee must begin construction and submit written notice to DEQ that construction has commenced.
By 2/28/2029	The permittee must submit a progress report to DEQ on construction of the project.

2. Responsibility to Meet Compliance Dates

No later than 14 days following each compliance date listed in the table above, the permittee must notify DEQ in writing of its compliance or noncompliance with the requirements. Any reports of noncompliance must include the cause of noncompliance, any remedial actions taken, and a discussion of the likelihood of meeting the next scheduled requirement(s).

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1. Justification for Modification

DEQ initiated a permit modification to change deadlines and requirements in Schedule C for compliance with final ammonia effluent limits. This modification is based on Mutual Agreement and Final Order No. WQ-M-WR-2021-131 Amendment 6 finalized with the City of Yoncalla on May 30, 2024. The City of Yoncalla has submitted a funding application to the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) to develop a pre-design report. CWSRF staff have indicated that if the application is approved, funds will not be dispersed until June 2025 or later. The proposed modification to the compliance dates is due to an event over which the permittee has little or no control. Based on this situation, the new proposed compliance dates are considered to require the permittee to meet the final ammonia effluent limits as soon as possible.

This permit modification changes compliance schedule deadlines to dates greater than 120 days after the dates specified in the existing permit and therefore is classified as a major modification in accordance with 40 CFR §122.62. No other changes are being made to the permit except those outlined in this document.
