- 1. The City of Troutdale recognizes the threat natural hazards pose to the people and property within Troutdale.

- 4. The process of updating the 2023 Plan is now complete, and the plan has been approved by both State and Federal agencies ensuring that it complies with requirements set forth in the Code of Federal Regulations (44 CFR §201.6).

- Section 1. The City Council hereby adopts the 2023 Multnomah County Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan
- Section 2. For all other intents and purposes, the Multnomah County Mult-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan shall be considered the City of Troutdale Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan.
