RE: Off-Site Contaminant Migration for Japanese Auto Repair in Portland

Mr. Greeninger:

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has completed an evaluation of available information on the Japanese Auto Repair property, located at 521 SE Taylor Street in Portland (tax lot 1S1E02BC01100).

Soil samples collected beneath the floor of the former Japanese Auto Repair warehouse in December 2016 and March 2017 identified contamination consistent with Stoddard solvent, a petroleum-based solvent used by dry cleaners from the 1930s through the 1950s. An environmental assessment of the Arcoa Building, northwest of the warehouse at 1006 SE Grand Avenue, identified a former dry cleaner (Allyn's Cleaning and Dyeing) that operated from a storefront between the Arcoa Building and the current 7-Eleven convenience store from at least 1935 to about 1960.

DEQ has determined that Allyn's Cleaning and Dyeing is the likely source of the Stoddard solvent contamination on the Japanese Auto Repair property. Consequently, under DEQ's Off-Site Contaminant Migration Policy, you will not be held responsible for the contamination that has migrated onto your property. A copy of DEQ's Off-Site Contaminant Migration Policy is enclosed with this letter.

Concurrent with this letter, DEQ will be sending a letter to the registered owners of the Arcoa Building property requiring them to investigate and, if necessary, remediate the contamination that originated on their property. You, or any future owners and/or operators of the Japanese Auto Repair property, will be given the opportunity to review and comment on any cleanup plans that may impact your property.
