Subject: Project Status Report—April through June 2024: Temco RI/FS Project

This memorandum presents the status report for the period of April through June 2024 for the Temco Engineered Products (Temco) remedial investigation/feasibility study (RI/FS) project in Clackamas, Oregon. This report has been prepared in accordance with the March 29, 2006 *Order on Consent* (LQSR-NWR-06-03) between the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) and Temco.

WORK COMPLETED APRIL THROUGH JUNE 2024

- Temco reviewed and prepared responses to DEQ comments on the Vapor Intrusion Investigation Work Plan. Responses were submitted to DEQ on May 29, 2024.
- Temco submitted the Revised Vapor Intrusion Investigation Work Plan to DEQ on June 3, 2024. DEQ approved the Revised Vapor Intrusion Work Plan on June 4, 2024.
- Temco has submitted application materials to Clackamas County for right of way permits necessary for completing the vapor intrusion investigation field work.

ACTIVITIES PLANNED JULY THROUGH AUGUST 2024

- Temco plans to review the May 16, 2024 *Final Data Evaluation Report, Supplemental Remedial Investigation (RI) and Focused Feasibility Study (FFS) at the Northwest Pipe & Casing Superfund Site, Clackamas, Oregon* prepared by CDM Smith on behalf of U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
- Obtain permits from Clackamas County for completing soil vapor borings in Clackamas County rights of way.
- Coordination with soil vapor investigation subcontractors (e.g., driller and laboratory) and implement the soil vapor investigation, pending permit issuance.

No sampling was performed during this reporting period. No test results or data were generated during this reporting period.
