There are 217 more meters left to inspect for the lead and copper inventory. The anticipated date of completion will be at the end of the month.

ENGINEER: Current updates on the following projects:

Summer Woods/Washington Ct. (6244 Washinton Ct.) This project has been authorized to start work in one day.

Carman Dr. improvements – Turney Excavation project has been finalized. The surveyors will be out tomorrow.

5357 Oakridge redevelopment – New service has been completed and the old service has been terminated.

Sunset Commons (16607 Boones Ferry) – This is still in the design phase.

Habitat for Humanity - The old service has been found and terminated.

5337 Bonita - Requires a new service and the termination of the existing service is still pending.

5342 Bonita – The existing home has been removed and the developer is building a new home. They have been advised of the District's requirements.

5751 Washington Court – This is a partition. The developer/owner has been contacted without a Response.

6122 Carman Drive - The owner has been contacted and was advised of the District's requirements.

Chick-fil-A: This project has been approved and a preconstruction is pending. A fire flow test is also required.

Capital Improvement (CIP) has been updated for 2024. The Gassner project has been proposed for 2026.
