The enclosed documents are important, so please review and complete them carefully. The above referenced permit will expire on 9-30-2024 and certain actions are required on your part to ensure a smooth reassignment process. If you no longer conduct activities which require this permit, please notify the Department in writing, so that your permit can be terminated.

Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 340-071-0162(12) requires a Water Pollution Control Facilities (WPCF) permit renewal application to be submitted at least 60 days prior to the expiration date of the current permit. In order to ensure you receive the automatic permit extension shield and to remain in compliance with our permitting regulations, your accurately completed application and current permitting **fees of \$1,465** must be received before the current permit expires on 9-30-2024. The fees noted in this reminder are subject to annual increases each year.

The application package should be mailed to:

Check payable to DEQ.

Failure to submit a permit renewal application at least 60 days prior to the current permit's expiration date is considered a violation of the DEQ permit rules and may disqualify an applicant from the automatic permit extension shield. Under this scenario, if the application is not received in a timely manner and the Department is not able to issue a new permit by the expiration date of the prior permit, the applicant would then be faced with the option of discontinuing operation until a new permit has been issued, or operating without a valid permit. Operating without a valid permit would be a violation of both state and federal environmental laws and potentially subject the violator to formal enforcement action which could result in a civil penalty assessment. Equally important is that the violator could also become subject to third party suits from either the private or public sector, which may be monitoring the Department's actions in the matter. We sincerely wish to avoid either of these occurrences. If your permit expires and you wish to continue operation of the system, a new permit would need to be applied for. Current fees for applying for a new permit are \$4,976 + the current ACD fee.

Please note that the renewal permitting fees should not be confused with the annual compliance fee you are invoiced for in July. The permitting fees are used to review applications and develop modifications to the permit. The annual compliance fee is used to review data and conduct inspections.
