DEQ has made the following corrections to the City of Ashland's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit no. 101609:

This permit modification addresses errors in Schedule B.3, the Outfalls 001, 002, and 004 effluent monitoring location was clarified as at the effluent diversion structure and Schedule C, Table C1, the September 1, 2023 deadline to submit a progress report was corrected to September 1, 2024.

The correction of these typographical errors are minor modifications that are not subject to public notice as detailed in OAR 340-045-0055(2)(a)(A).

Pursuant to OAR 340-045-055(4), this modification will become effective August 27, 2024 unless the city requests a hearing within 20 days. A request for a hearing must be made to the DEQ director in writing and state the grounds for the request. Any hearing will be conducted as a contested case hearing in accordance with ORS 183.413 through 183.470 and OAR 340-011. If a hearing is requested, the existing permit continues in effect until a final order is issued.
