

DEQ seeks comments on proposed Prospective Purchaser Agreement for a former gasoline station in Cornelius

The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality seeks comments on its proposed Consent Order for a Prospective Purchaser Agreement with the City of Cornelius concerning the acquisition of a former gasoline station property at 1021 E. Baseline Street in Cornelius. The property would be redeveloped for mixed residential and commercial use. Five out-of-compliance underground storage tanks used by the former gasoline station at the property would be permanently decommissioned.
