BUDGET COMMITTEE MINUTES May 10, 2021

1. CALL TO ORDER & PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Board of Commissioners Chair Boice called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m. Present Brad Alcorn, Douglas Baker, Wayne Krieger Court Boice, and Christopher Paasch.

Absent: John Herzog. (Herzog joined meeting at 9:52 a.m.)

The Pledge was recited by all.

Boice read a statement about budget issues during his term as Commissioner and displayed a Word document titled "Re: General Audit Fund in Order."

2. ELECT CHAIR

Paasch nominates Brad Alcorn as Chair of committee.

Motion by Paasch, seconded by Boice, to appoint Alcorn as Chair. Motion carried unanimously.

3. BUDGET ORIENTATION
