#### **POSITION SUMMARY:**

Juvenile litter patrol crews primarily pick up litter along the state highways in Curry County. Litter crews have a crew leader and may be asked to complete others tasks as time allows. This program was founded in 1977 to assist in cleaning up highway rights of way. This is a great opportunity to work outdoors in a team environment and have a role in maintaining state highways and helping the environment.

### **QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

- Be able to pick up and bag litter along the highway.
- Be physically able to walk along the highway.
- Be able to lift and carry filled bags.
- Be willing to work in all types of weather conditions in a safe manner along roadways with varying levels of traffic.

Litter crews are hired as temporary employees and are not eligible for insurance, vacation, or personal leave. Crews may work full-time or part-time and hours assigned may vary. This job will start mid-June and last 8 weeks.

Crew Members: Youth must be 16 years or older on start date

Crew Leaders: Must be at least 18 years or older. Must have a valid Oregon Driver License and acceptable driving record.
