WHEREAS, Curry County has received the first installment of American Rescue Plan ("ARP") funds; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Brookings has demonstrated need for ARP funds under Priority No. 2.36 (Aid to Other Impacted Industries); and

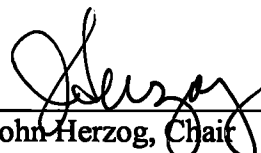
WHEREAS, the Port of Brookings requests an allocation of \$50,000.00 of ARP funds to be used for critical projects with the exception that no funds shall be expended in relation to the wastewater treatment plant.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. \$50,000.00 of American Rescue Plan (ARP) Funds are allocated to the Port of Brookings for the purpose of use on critical projects with the exception that no funds shall be expended in relation to the wastewater treatment plant.
2. Receipt of funds is contingent on proper compliance and reporting set out by the Final Interim Rule effective April 1st, 2022, and the SLFRF Compliance and Reporting Guidance published by the United States Treasury.

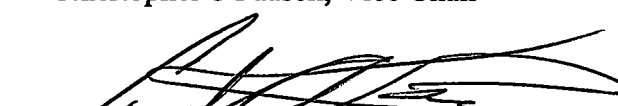
