WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 654.176(a) and OAR 437-001-0765(2), every public or private employer of eleven (11) or more employees must establish and administer a safety committee; and

WHEREAS, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) requires an equal number of employer and employee representatives on the Safety Committee or a greater number of employee representatives than employer representatives if agreed upon by all parties; and

WHEREAS, Curry County has had a Safety Committee for a number of years but recently the Committee has experienced many resignations; and

WHEREAS, some questions have arisen regarding the nature, responsibilities, and composition of the Curry County Safety Committee; and

WHEREAS, State Courts has a presence on County premises, therefore, it has been determined that the State of Oregon shall be represented on the Safety Committee by one voting member; and

WHEREAS, County Legal Counsel represents the interests of the County as it pertains to safety concerns and thus the Legal Counsel position should maintain a Safety Committee appointment perpetually.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF CURRY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Curry County Safety Committee is reorganized to now include three (3) employer representatives and five (5) employee representatives/volunteers for a total of eight (8) members.
- 2. Terms for all Safety Committee Members shall be for two (2) years, except for County Counsel, who shall remain appointed in perpetuity.
- 3. Renee Kolen and Wendy Lang are hereby appointed as employer representatives, with terms effective from August 14, 2022 to August 14, 2024.

- 4. County Legal Counsel is hereby appointed as an employer representative with a perpetual term, until otherwise ordered by the Board.
- 5. Ida Swank, Miranda Plagge, Waylon Somers, and Jonathan Wills are hereby appointed as volunteer employee representatives, with terms effective from August 14, 2022 to August 14, 2024.
- 6. Kara Breuer is hereby appointed as a State Court representative, with a term effective August 14, 2022 to August 14, 2024.
- 7. All prior Board Resolutions and Orders, including but not limited to Orders 20561, 20778, 20873, 20933, 21077, 22023, 22036, 22091, 22097; and all others which are inconsistent with this Order, are hereby repealed.
