**WHEREAS**, Curry County will receive two (2) properties from Curry Community Health as a result of a reverter clause. On January 1, 2022, title to these properties will be re-vested in Curry County; and

**WHEREAS**, due to their value to the community, it is desired that the above-referenced properties, located at 29845 Airport Road (also known as the Clubhouse) and 29833 Airport Road (also known as the Hammond House), continue to be used in some capacity to facilitate public needs; and

**WHEREAS**, a representative from ADAPT Oregon has made proposals as to the use of regarding their potential use as low income housing as well as mental health service location; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the urgency and importance of this project, it is prudent that the Board select a signatory to facilitate communication and authorize the agreements.

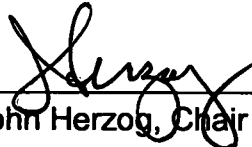
**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

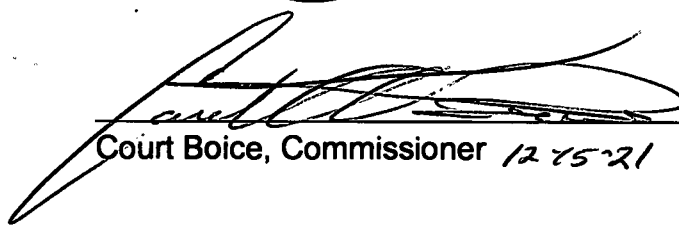
