WHEREAS, historically, the celebration of Independence Day in Southern Oregon Coast communities, more specifically, our ports, has drawn record numbers of visitors; and,

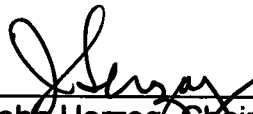
WHEREAS, the past two years of COVID have greatly hindered the ability to execute and fundraise for expenses like firework shows, therefore rendering July 4th events handicapped or disabled; and,

WHEREAS, with the rising cost of goods and services pricing events out of existence, a hand up in sustaining and rebuilding the draw of tourism on the Southern Oregon Coast for the Independence holiday weekend brought a unanimous vote in support by the Tourism Promotions Committee at their January meeting, with a commitment of \$10,000.00 to south, central and north Curry County; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Transient Lodging Tax funds designated to the Tourism Promotions Committee be distributed as follows; \$10,000.00 to north county, \$10,000.00 to south county and \$10,000.00 to central county event agents of Curry County in support of executing July 4th holiday events.

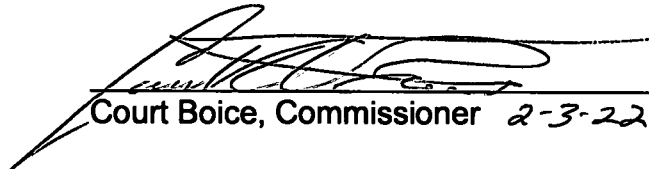

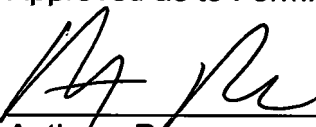
