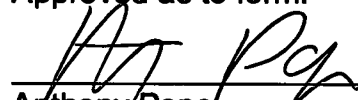
WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Curry County, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, is in agreement with the above stated recommendation;

POSITION SUMMARY:

Performs a variety of manual and semi-skilled tasks and operates light automotive and other equipment used in the general construction and maintenance of county roads, bridges and other related facilities. Performs related work as required.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Flags, controls and directs traffic.

Operates utility vehicles (pickups, crewcabs, 2.5 yard dump, etc.), chipper, chain saw and other equipment.

Performs manual labor digging ditches, cleaning and installing culverts, building fences, cutting and disposing of brush, setting chokers, installing guardrails and traffic signs and removing litter and debris from roadway and adjacent area.

Other duties may be assigned.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES:

Supervision of other employees is not a responsibility of positions in this classification.

Must have reasonable knowledge of the rules of safe operation of the equipment operated by this classification and the precautions to be taken to avoid accidents.

Must have some knowledge of the appropriate tools, equipment, materials and procedures used in road construction and maintenance.

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QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Must have reasonable skill in the safe operation of automotive and light equipment (chain saw, post hole digger, brush chipper, compactor, etc.).

Must have skill in using hand tools including rakes and shovels. Must have the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with other employees and the public.

Must be able to understand and follow oral and written instructions.

EDUCATION AND/OR EXPERIENCE:

Some experience in general maintenance and construction work; sufficient education to demonstrate the ability to read and write; or any satisfactory equivalent combination of experience and training which demonstrates the ability to perform the duties.

Requires possession of a valid Oregon Drivers License.

Requires possession of a current certificate of completion of the ODOT Work Zone Traffic Control Course (Flaggers Card).

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

Must have the ability to perform strenuous physical tasks.

Must have the ability to work in variable and inclement weather conditions.

Must have the ability to deal effectively with stress.

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform these essential functions.

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WORK ENVIRONMENT:

The noise level in the work environment may be high at times.

The weather in the work environment will variable and may be adverse at times.
