WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 20-01 (known as the Property Registration Ordinance), the County implemented a requirement that all property owners not residing in Curry County more than six months per year register their property with the County, and

WHEREAS, there has been expressed confusion regarding the assessment of registration fees under the Property Registration Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, the intention of the Property Registration Ordinance was to assess one fee per contiguous tract of ownership.

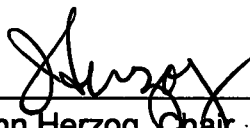
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Tracts of contiguous ownership including multiple parcels will be charged a single registration fee.

Parcels distinct in location or separated by road or other ownership but owned by the same entity will be subject to a registration fee for each parcel.

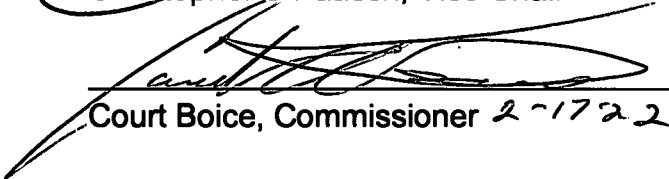

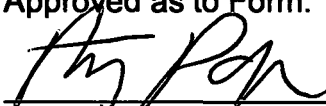
