I have received approval to move forward with the No Further Action determination for LUST 20-24-0560 (Former Emerald Chrysler Products).

There are a couple of avenues for closure. Please let me know which option you would like to pursue.

Standard Process

The current timeline for sending a final invoice is approximately 1-2 months. Once our business office receives payment and I am notified of payment, we can release the No Further Action Letter.

Expedited Process

Alternatively, we can request an *estimated* final invoice from our accounting office. Accounting will provide me with an estimated final invoice amount. Unfortunately, I won't be able to provide you with a formal invoice for this estimate final invoice. Once it is paid, we can release the No Further Action letter. If you are close to our Eugene or Salem office, you have the option to hand in a check in exchange for the signed NFA. In a couple of months, you will receive the formal final invoice. If you overpaid, accounting will issue a refund check. If you were underpaid, there may be a small remaining amount outstanding for which you get invoiced.

I know you are under a time constraint. Please let me know how you would like to proceed with the final invoice payment so I can coordinate with our accounting staff.
