Dear Mr. Wullschlager:

The City of Lapine operates a domestic wastewater treatment facility which produces recycled water for land application in accordance with Water Pollution Control Facilities (WPCF) Permit #102069. The facility proposed the addition of a new land application site located east of the treatment facility. This modification to recycled water activities required the City to submit an updated Recycled Water Use Plan (RWUP) for review by DEQ. La Pine submitted a draft RWUP on 4/1/24.

DEQ staff reviewed the RWUP submitted. Based on this review, and on the changes that the City made to the plan in response to DEQ comments, DEQ approves the updated RWUP submitted by Fry Ontario on 10/9/24, subject to the condition described below.

Unfortunately, DEQ staff failed to notify the city that an environmental management plan review fee is required for DEQ to review the RWUP. By 11/22/24, please send a check for \$923, made out to the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality, to the address below:

Despite the fact that the required payment has not been resolved, discharge of recycled water in accordance with the approved RWUP may begin upon receipt of this letter.

The assigned WPCF permit conditions must be adhered to at all times. All activities pertaining to the management, treatment, discharge, and disposal of all recycled water must be conducted in accordance with an approved RWUP and any amendments to the RWUP approved in writing by the DEQ.
