IN THE MATTER OF THE REPEAL OF THE 2023 WASCO COUNTY FEE SCHEDULE ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE 24-004

NOW ON THIS DAY, the above-entitled matter having come on regularly for consideration, said day being one duly set in term for the transaction of public business and a majority of the Board of Commissioners being present; and

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WASCO COUNTY OREGON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 FINDINGS

- a) Oregon Statute ORS 294.160 allows counties to set fees through the adoption of an Ordinance approval of a resolution.
- b) Passage of an Ordinance creates a delay in implementing new fees or increasing existing fees.
- c) The County has determined that the Resolution process provides a more flexible and efficient path to annual or periodic revision of the Wasco County Fee Schedule going forward.

Section 2 REPEAL OF ORDINANCE

- a) Ordinance 23-001, dated September 20, 2023, and all other ordinances, orders, or resolutions or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3 Severability

- a) If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or unlawful, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Board hereby declares that it would have passed each phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more of such provisions be declared unconstitutional or unlawful.

Section 4 EFFECTIVE DATE

- a) This Ordinance shall take effect on the 1st day of January, 2025.


