Your Water Pollution Control Facilities Permit Mod #4 has been issued and is attached. This permit is DEQ's final action on the permit modification request documents you submitted on 8/12/2024 and 9/5/2024. DEQ did receive public comments and the comments you provided during the public notice period. Minor changes were made to the proposed permit as a result of the comments considered during the notice period. Your permit modification is now effective, however please note that the following conditions apply regarding the land expansion:

Prior to use of Farm 6 for wastewater application, all permit requirements regarding land application must be met, including but not limited to:

- 1) A signed and completed land use compatibility statement (LUCS) must be provided to DEQ.
- 2) Plans and specifications for any wastewater infrastructure must be provided to DEQ and approved prior to construction and use.
- 3) Groundwater monitoring as per the permit must commence prior to land application at the expansion sites.
- 4) Risk ranking of each site at Farm 6 must also be completed prior to use in accordance with the permit and the facility's Mutual Agreement and Order (WQ/I-ER-2021-106).

Please read your permit carefully. Compliance with your permit and permit modification is required at all times.

If you are dissatisfied with the conditions of this permit, you have 20 days to request a hearing before the Environmental Quality Commission or its authorized representative. A request for a hearing must be made in writing and state the grounds for the request. Any hearing will be conducted as a contested case hearing in accordance with ORS 183.413 through 183.470 and OAR chapter 340, division 011. If a hearing is requested, the existing permit continues in effect until a final order is issued.
