

2017-19 Legislative Approved Budget = \$ 3.5 Million




### Proposed Hazardous Waste Fee Increases

### **Background – Hazardous Waste Program Fees**

- Projected \$1.2-\$1.5 million revenue deficit in revenue
- Fee increases needed as program operating costs increase
- Federal and state statutes authorize fee increases to implement program
