

Greenhouse Gas Reporting Program Background


The program collects data on sources that comprise over 80% of annual statewide emissions including:

- 217 Permitted Facilities
- 85 Fuel Importers
- 7 Natural Gas Suppliers
- 47 Electricity Suppliers

Overview of Proposed Rule Changes

- Clarify language and terms in the rule
- Update the reference to the federal greenhouse gas reporting rule quantification methodology
- Provide the program with clear investigative authority to collect information from all entities required to report

Clarification of Investigative Authority

Investigative Authority (ORS 468.095):

- Grants DEQ authority to inspect actual or suspected sources.
- Grants the EQC access to records relating to an inspection.

Proposed Rule Language:

All persons required to report under this division must provide in a reasonably timely manner any and all information that DEQ requires for the purposes of assessing applicability, verifying or investigating either actual or suspected sources of greenhouse gas emissions or to ascertain compliance or noncompliance with rules in this division.

DEQ Recommendation

- DEQ recommends that the Environmental Quality Commission adopt the proposed rules seen on pages 20 through 29 as part of Chapter 340 of the Oregon Administrative Rules.
