This letter report summarizes the findings of the preliminary tank replacement assessment at ARCO Service Station No. 6118 located at NW Lombard and Portsmouth Streets, Portland, Oregon.

INTRODUCTION

ARCO authorized Sweet-Edwards/EMCON, Inc. (SE/E) to perform soil borings and lab testing of soil as outlined in ARCO's ARCO Retail Marketing Environmental Procedure: Preliminary Tank Replacement Assessment.

SOIL BORINGS AND SAMPLING

On October 31, 1989, a total of 3 borings (B-1, B-2 and B-3) were drilled adjacent to the tank complex (see Figure 1). Drilling was performed using a 3.75-inch I.D. hollow-stem auger and a CME 55 drill rig owned and operated by Geo-Tech Exploration of Portland, Oregon. An SE/E engineer was present during all drilling activities performed at the site.

Soil samples were collected from each boring at five foot intervals using the standard penetration test method. All samples were field screened using a photoionization detector. Soil samples were placed in laboratory supplied glass containers and placed on ice in a cooler. Samples were shipped to Columbia Analytical Services, Kelso, Washington for analysis using chain-of-custody procedures.

The borings penetrated approximately 1 foot of asphalt and gravel subbase. Sand was then encountered to 17 feet during drilling. Sandy gravel was encountered from 17 feet to 31.5 feet. All borings were completed at a total depth of 31.5 feet below ground surface (see boring logs, Appendix A).

Ground water was not encountered. No gasoline odors were detected in the split spoon samples or spoils. The borings were backfilled with bentonite chips upon completion. Spoils generated from drilling were stockpiled behind the store (see Figure 1) and covered with visqueen. A representative sample was collected from the stockpiled spoils.

ANALYTICAL RESULTS

Selected soil samples were analyzed for total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) by U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Method 418.1. No soil samples analyzed had concentrating of TPH above 14 parts per million (ppm). The results are summarized in Table 1 below.

CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

- Based on the most stringent TPH soil clean-up concentration in the Oregon Matrix (OAR 340-122-205 through OAR 340-12-360) of 40 ppm, no concentrations of TPH were detected in exceedence of this limit.
- SE/E recommends no further action at present because there is no detected evidence of a release exceeding clean-up standards.
- SE/E recommends normal Matrix sampling protocol be followed when the tanks are removed in 1991.

The Department of Environmental Quality has completed its review of the Sweet-Edwards/EMCON, Inc. report dated January 28, 1991, regarding the soil borings and laboratory testing of soil samples collected at Arco Station #6118 located at the corner of NW Lombard and NW Portsmouth Streets, Portland, Oregon. The Department has determined that there appears to be no evidence of a petroleum release exceeding current cleanup standards and that no further action is required at this time.

This determination is a result of our evaluation and judgement based on the regulations and facts as we now understand them, including:

- 1. Three soil borings were drilled adjacent to the tank complex and soil samples collected from each boring at five foot intervals down to 30 feet.
- 2. Nine soil samples were analyzed using EPA Method 418.1. The highest concentration of petroleum hydrocarbons was 14 parts per million (ppm). This result is below the most stringent cleanup level of 40 ppm for gasoline and 100 ppm for diesel.
- 3. Groundwater was not encountered in the borings.

The Department's determination will not be applicable if new or undisclosed facts show that the investigation does not comply with the Department's rules. The Department's determination also does not apply to any conditions at the site other than the results of the soil borings and subsequent soil sampling addressed in the report. We recommend that a copy of this information be kept with the permanent facility records.

Dear Mr.Christie:

As required by Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR), a release has been reported from an underground storage tank (UST) system at your facility. This initial information indicates that groundwater was not encountered and that the concentration of contamination discovered may be less than 40 parts per million (ppm) of Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons (TPH).

40 ppm TPH is the most stringent cleanup level established by OAR 340-122-205 through 340-122-360 for simple soil cleanups. Cleanup is not required for those sites with contamination below the 40 ppm level. However, the Department requires that a report be submitted that documents the contamination levels found. The report should include 1) a brief narrative of activities at the site and 2) a copy of the analytical data for all samples collected. Once we receive your report that verifies the contamination detected was below the 40 ppm cleanup level, and that the requirements of OAR 340-122-205 through 360 were met, a letter will be sent to you that indicates that no further action is required at your facility.
