Dear Oregon Air National Guard,

The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is conducting underground storage tank (UST) inspections throughout Oregon. The purpose of this letter is to inform you that your facility(s), among others, has been selected for inspection. A thorough inspection of your facility will be conducted to determine compliance with state and federal UST requirements. **The date you receive this letter is the date that the inspection starts.** If you have work done after that date, you will need to have the previous set of records available for evaluation in addition to the most recent records.

The inspection for this facility is scheduled for Wednesday April 12, 2023. The inspection will start at approximately 9:00 am located at 6801 NE Cornfoot Rd in Portland.

Please read this entire notice and contact the DEQ inspector if you have questions about the upcoming inspection.

You must contact the inspector at least two (2) weeks prior to the date above to reschedule if you are unavailable at the stated time. Failure to reschedule within this time frame may result in enforcement actions.

The inspections will require uninterrupted participation and attendance by you or a knowledgeable assistant. For the inspections you need to provide access to tank sumps, under dispenser areas, cathodic protection rectifiers, and leak monitoring equipment. DEQ will not touch the equipment or enter the facility; **if you are unable to assist with equipment access, please have your UST Service Provider there.** This inspection may also include review of Stage I Vapor Recovery.

The DEQ requests the following documentation be submitted electronically prior to the inspection to lauren.dimock@deq.oregon.gov. If these records cannot be submitted prior to the inspection, please have them available for review at the facility.

- Line and leak detector testing results for the past three years,
- Monthly tank leak detection records for the past 12 months,
- Class A, B, and C training documentation,
- Financial responsibility mechanism,
- Annual tank gauge certification,
- Spill prevention testing records,
- Monthly walkthroughs for the past 12 months,
- Overfill Prevention Equipment testing,
- Cathodic protection testing (if applicable).

Upon request, the DEQ inspector may allow up to five (5) days after the inspection to accept missing documents prior to making a final compliance determination. Any records submitted after an approved five (5) day extension will not be included for compliance determination and the inspection will be considered closed.

As stated previously, DEQ will not touch any equipment and if you are unable to assist with equipment access, please have your UST Service Provider there to remove manway or sump lids. DEQ will need to observe what equipment is in the tank top sumps and under the dispensers. If ball floats are the primary overfill protection device, these will need to be verified during the inspection, please be able to locate and remove the ball floats.

If violations are found at the time of the inspection without prior notification, DEQ is required to initiate enforcement action. For UST violations, enforcement usually begins with a field citation option, which is much like paying a traffic ticket and making corrections. Some enforcement situations, including repeat violations and significant compliance deficiencies, will go through a longer and more formal process through the Office of Compliance and Enforcement and can potentially lead to larger penalties.

Field Citation Requirements

The permittee or owner should select Option 1 or Option 2 and return a signed copy of Page 1 of the Field Citation form within thirty (30) days of issuance of the Field Citation. If the permittee or owner fails to sign and send Page 1 of the Field Citation form back or pay the penalty within thirty days, Option 1 expires, the Field Citation will serve as a Pre-Enforcement Notice (PEN) and the permittee and owner will be subject to formal enforcement including the imposition of civil penalties in accordance with OAR Chapter 340, Division 12.

The permittee or owner must complete the actions required to correct the violations listed on the Field Citation by the date specified to prevent further enforcement action by DEQ.

Option 1:

By checking Option 1 the permittee or owner acknowledges that the violations listed on Page 3 of this Field Citation have occurred and agrees to pay the established penalty.

By submitting payment of the penalty amount, the responding permittee or owner agrees to accept the field citation as a final order of the Environmental Quality Commission (commission) and waives any and all rights and objections to the form, content, manner of service and timeliness of the Field Citation; to a contested case hearing and judicial review of the Field Citation [OAR 340-150-0250(6)]; and to service of a copy of this Final Order (*i.e.*, no other copy will be provided).

Upon the Department's receipt of payment of the penalty amount set forth in the Field Citation, the Field Citation becomes a Final Order of the Commission that:

1. Imposes upon the permittee or owner a civil penalty in the amount listed on Page 1 of this Field Citation; and
2. Requires the permittee or owner to satisfactorily complete the requirements and actions necessary to correct the violations documented by the dates set forth on Page 3 of this Field Citation.

Failure by the permittee or owner to complete the actions set forth on Page 3 of the Field Citation by the specified date violates the Commission Order and subjects the permittee and owner to a formal enforcement action including the imposition of additional civil penalties.

Option 2:

The permittee or owner may deny that the violations as listed on Page 3 of this Field Citation have occurred or contest the Field Citation process by checking Option 2 and submitting to the Department a signed copy of Page 1 of the Field Citation. In that event, the Field Citation will serve as a Pre-Enforcement Notice (PEN) and the permittee and owner will be subject to formal enforcement for those violations set forth in the Field Citation, including the imposition of civil penalties in accordance with OAR Chapter 340, Division 12. Emily,

I am only able to pay the \$500 by my gov't issued Mastercard (see attached example of most recent DEQ payment). I would like to pay this \$500 by gov't credit card instead of a check by using the same request form as the one I've attached referencing the Program Enforcement No. 2024-FC-9721 in line 8 of the DEQ Electronic payment form (also attaching page one of the citation with option 1 selected and signed by our commander).

We will be addressing violation #2 by testing overfill prevention mechanism and submit methodology of testing to the DEQ by 12/31/24 IAW OAR 340-150-310 (attached) based on the following:

- a. SME evaluated both USTs on site on 25 NOV 24 and determined that both have existing overfill alarms that were set at 70% capacity and are functioning
 1. UST 260-1 (tank permit no. BGCFH) already had a feature in the existing Veeder Root TLS-250 that senses and audibly alarms for tank overfilling. The alarm was forced to turn on when SME removed the sensor (simulating high level). We have yet to fill the tank up with water to the 70% capacity level to see if the alarm goes off in the presence of SME which will allow them to complete the in-compliance report (note: after this test is completed, the added water will be pumped into the connected oil/water separator IAW our city of Portland sanitary sewer discharge permit).

2. UST 200-1 (tank permit no. BFCFG) already has a Warrick/Gems product level sensor with audible alarm (alarm was tested as functional) by SME. We have yet to fill the tank up with water to the 70% capacity level to see if the alarm goes off in the presence of SME which will allow them to complete the in-compliance report. (note: after this test is completed, the added water will be pumped into the connected oil/water separator IAW our city of Portland sanitary sewer discharge permit).

As I explained on the phone, the communications you received at the time of registration in 2007 about any exemption from overfill requirements no longer apply after the rule update that came into effect in Oregon on October 1, 2020.

Please let me know by 12/15/24 whether you plan to decommission these 2 tanks in a timely manner, or to install overfill alarms that meet the requirements of OAR 340-150-0310. Remember that all UST work (either system modifications or decommissionings) must be performed by a licensed UST Service Provider, and you must notify DEQ at least 30 days before beginning the work.

Dylan,

Our USTs can only receive floating product from oil/water separators discharging to sanitary sewer. Any UST overfilling would discharge only to sanitary sewer (not regulated under the UST rules). Under our sanitary sewer discharge permit with the city, we have manual controls in place to alert us when our oil/water separators need to be pumped out to avoid discharging oils to the city sanitary sewer treatment plant. Please let me know if this information clears us of this violation notice to the Oregon Air Nat'l Guard.

No overfill prevention mechanism testing was included in the paperwork from SME. Can you please submit this....

This email has two intended recipients: you (permittee) and our enforcement/follow-up team. Because of this split audience, there might be some jargon used which is for DEQ internal purposes.

I'll be asking for paperwork/documentation by a specific time and will state the violation/corrective action if the work is not submitted or was not performed. Please note the deadline for submissions.... After that deadline has passed, the inspection is closed for additional information and a determination will be assessed given the available information. By not submitting the requested documents, you might be assessed citations for items which were completed but DEQ simply does not have evidence for.
