WHEREAS; suicide is a major public health problem with immediate and long-term effects on individuals, families and communities, and

WHEREAS, suicidal thoughts can affect anyone regardless of age, gender, race, orientation, income level, religion, or background; and suicide is a major public health issue that requires vigilant attention and preventative action, and

WHEREAS, the ongoing stressors brought by the COVID-19 pandemic, stay-at-home mandates, economic turmoil, social unrest, and growing inequality likely modified risk for self-harm, and

WHEREAS, 878 Oregonians lost their lives to suicide in 2022, and

WHEREAS, more Curry County citizens lost their lives to suicide in 2022 than in any previous year, and

WHEREAS, suicide was the 9th leading cause of death in Oregon in 2020, and the 2nd leading cause of death for 10-44 year-olds, and

WHEREAS, each death by suicide directly impacts numerous family members, friends, loved ones, and by extension our entire rural community; and

WHEREAS, research shows that 95% of adults would do something if someone close to them was thinking about suicide if they only knew what to say or do.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Brookings City Council hereby proclaims September 2023 as

Suicide Awareness and Prevention Month

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council encourages all citizens to learn the warning signs, trust their gut and use that information to ask a troubled friend, colleague or family member "Are you okay?" in your way.

Councilor Schreiber moved, Councilor Hodges seconded, and Council voted unanimously to authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with CR Contracting in the amount of \$324,994 for the taxiway sealcoating project at the Brookings Airport, contingent on FAA grant approval.

4. Wastewater Pump Station Repairs Award Staff report presented by Tony Baron

Councilor Martin moved, Councilor Schreiber seconded, and Council voted unanimously to authorize City Manager to enter into an agreement with MJ Glazebrook Construction in the amount of \$66,927 for Wastewater Pump Station Repairs.

Subject: Public Works Backhoe Purchase

Recommended Motion:

Authorize the City Manager to sign agreement with Central Machinery to purchase the Case 580SVJohn Deere 410P Backhoe in the amount of \$129,705.

Financial Impact:

\$129,705 from Capital Projects Reserve Fund.

Background/Discussion:

The Public Works Department currently has a 1994 Case 580K backhoe and a 1998 Case 580L Backhoe. The 1994 backhoe is nearly 30 years old, has a variety of mechanical issues and currently out of commission. It is slated for surplus in the next couple weeks. The 1998 backhoe is in good working condition and will take the place of the 1994 in the upper yard which is primarily used for loading and unloading materials. The new backhoe will serve the crew in the field and in the Public Works Yard.

Through the budget process, staff identified the need to replace the 1994 Backhoe in 2020 and began setting aside funds over several budget cycles in order to make the purchase.

Public Works Supervisor Tim Brush researched and received estimates from three separate backhoe manufacturers.

Staff recommends purchase of a Case 580SV backhoe from the low bidder, Central Machinery.

Geotechnical services was not included in the Dyer task order therefore the city was required to contracted separately with GRI to do the work. Geotechnical Resources Inc. (GRI) estimates the change order for additional slope stabilization analysis on the Tidewater Reservoir replacement project at \$5,500. GENERAL

The general scope of the project is to provide construction management services for the surface sealing of airport pavements at the Brookings Airport. The extents of the sealing are based on deferred maintenance identified in the 2019 Oregon Department of Aviation PEP Report and design work performed in the previous design phase.

This scope of work details activities and work elements needed for Century West Engineering (the Consultant) to perform construction management and project closeout services for the work.

The construction improvements include:

- 1. Minor crack repair on Taxiway A, Taxiway B and three (3) connector taxiways;
- 2. Slurry seal of Taxiway A, Taxiway B and three (3) connector taxiways;
- 3. Minor crack repair on taxilanes;
- 4. Slurry seal of taxilanes;
- 5. Minor crack repair on (City owned) aprons;
- 6. Slurry seal of (City owned) aprons;
- 7. Install taxiway, taxilane, and apron markings.

Services to be performed are as follows:

Administrative activity for the project is expected to occur over a 6-month period, an allowance of 3-hours per month of activity is provided.

- 3. Assist City as necessary with preparation of grant application including updated data sheet and sponsor certifications for the project and submit to City for review and signatures.
- 4. Provide a project schedule to City and FAA. Up to 2 revisions are anticipated.
- 5. Coordinate project team
- 6. Prepare and submit FAA Quarterly Performance Reports throughout the project.

Task 2 Construction Management

- 1. Organize, conduct and attend a Pre-construction Conference. The Project Manager and Resident Engineer will attend the meeting. Prepare an agenda and meeting notes for the meeting.
- 2. Prepare and submit weekly inspection reports to the FAA and the City. 5 weekly reports are anticipated.
- 3. Provide on-site observation during the project construction period. On-site activities include observing and reviewing Contractor work for conformance with the contract documents, making field measurements, preparation of inspection reports, photographic documentation, addressing field questions, monitoring construction progress, conducting wage rate interviews, and field verification of construction quantities for pay requests.

Activities related to this task are expected to occur over 12 working days within a 30 consecutive calendar day period. Century West will assign a staff member to the site during construction for this task. Full-time, on-site inspection is assumed to include 12 hours per working day, plus time for up to 3 round trips. 12 days are estimated for lodging during construction.

The actual amount of time for on-site observation is dependent on the Contractor's work plan and schedule. The City and Engineer agree to adjust this level of effort, if

necessary, due to a Contractor schedule that requires more observation than the assumed allowances.

- 4. Answer questions, provide clarifications, and prepare change orders or field orders, as necessary. An allowance of 8 hours will be made to accommodate this effort.

- 7. Coordinate required closures and Notice(s) to Airmen ("NOTAM's") with the City, users, and tenants.
- 8. Prepare and confirm monthly construction payment estimates and submit those estimates to the City. 2 monthly pay requests are anticipated.
- 9. Conduct and document periodic wage rate interviews.
- 10. Conduct an inspection at substantial completion with the City, and Contractor. Prepare punch list as necessary. The Resident Engineer will attend.
- 11. Conduct a final inspection once all punch list items are complete. 1 site visit by the Project Manager is allocated.
