Adoption of Final Order

- At its September meeting, the Commission considered argument in the Safety-Kleen contested case.
- The Commission directed counsel to prepare a final order consistent with DEQ's legal argument regarding interpretation of the rule at issue.
- The Commission further directed that the order should not assess a civil penalty or cite Respondent for violations.
- Counsel has prepared the order for the Commission's consideration.
