IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ROAD OFFICIAL TO PERFORM ROAD MAINTENANCE ON MAIN STREET, TYGH VALLEY, A LOCAL ACCESS ROAD IN WASCO COUNTY

ORDER #24-061

NOW ON THIS DAY, the above-entitled matter having come on regularly for consideration, said day being one duly set in term for the transaction of public business and a majority of the Board of Commissioners being present; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 368.031(1), the County is not liable for failure to improve a local access road or to keep it in repair, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 368.031(2), the County may only spend County moneys on a local access road if the work is an emergency, or if the County Road Official recommends the expenditure, the public use of the road justifies the expenditure proposed, and the County governing body enacts an order or resolution authorizing the work and designating the work to be either a single project or a continuing program; and

WHEREAS, the County Road Official has recommended that the County perform maintenance on Main Street, Tygh Valley, a local access road within the County's jurisdiction, as shown on the map accompanying the Road Official's recommendation, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and is incorporated herein by this reference;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The County Road Department is authorized to perform maintenance on the portion of Main Street, Tygh Valley, as a single project as shown on the attached Exhibit A, as may be necessary.
2. Main Street shall remain a local access road, and shall not be a county road.

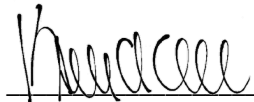
